



## **Environmentally Responsible Wood & Wood Fibre Procurement Policy for New Zealand**

Carter Holt Harvey LVL Limited (Futurebuild LVL) is committed to managing its businesses in a responsible manner including environmentally responsible procurement of wood.

Procuring wood from environmentally sustainable sources is one of the actions Futurebuild LVL can take to promote sustainable environmental management for the benefit of current and future generations.

This policy will be adhered to by the manufacturing sites in New Zealand owned and managed by Futurebuild LVL and shall apply to all wood and wood fibre procurement activities.

Wood and wood fibre purchased for processing, remanufacture and on-sale will originate from 'Sustainable Sources'.

Sustainable sources of wood and wood fibre include those meeting the following criteria:

- All wood fibre that is sourced from sustainable plantation forests that are managed in compliance with applicable law and regulations, as confirmed by Futurebuild LVL's assessment against the criteria given in FSC-STD-40-005v2
- All wood fibre sourced from Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) certified sources

Sustainable and controlled sources exclude sources of wood and wood fibre derived from:

- Illegal logging or the trade in illegal wood or forest products;
- Violation of traditional and human rights in forestry operations;
- Destruction of high conservation value areas in forestry operations;
- Significant conversion of natural forests to plantations or non-forest use;
- Introduction of genetically modified organisms, being organisms originating from recombinant transgenic techniques, in forestry operations;
- The violation of any of the International Labour Organisation (ILO) core conventions, as defined in the ILO Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights Work – 1998, namely:
  - Eliminating all forms of forced or compulsory labour
  - The abolition of child labour
  - The elimination of discrimination in respect of employment
  - Freedom of association and the right to collective bargaining

Futurebuild LVL sourcing policy requires Futurebuild LVL to verify and monitor its sources. Any exceptions to this policy must be escalated to and approved at General Manager level or higher to ensure an optimal commercial and environmentally sustainable outcome is reached.

All employees and direct customers will be advised of this policy.
